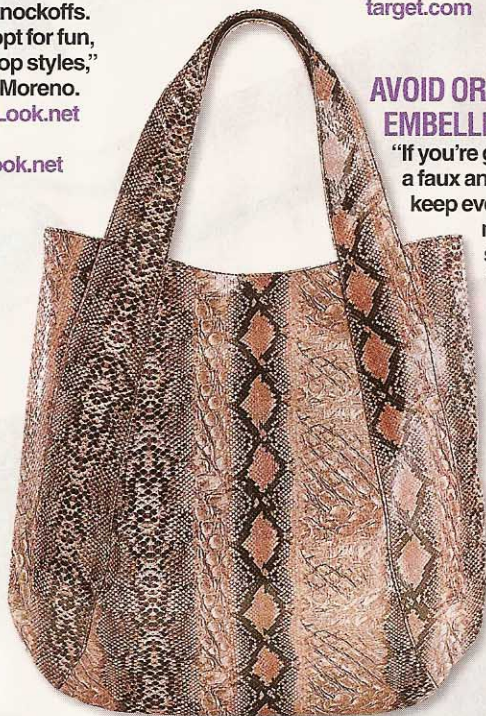
KEEP IT PLAYFUL
