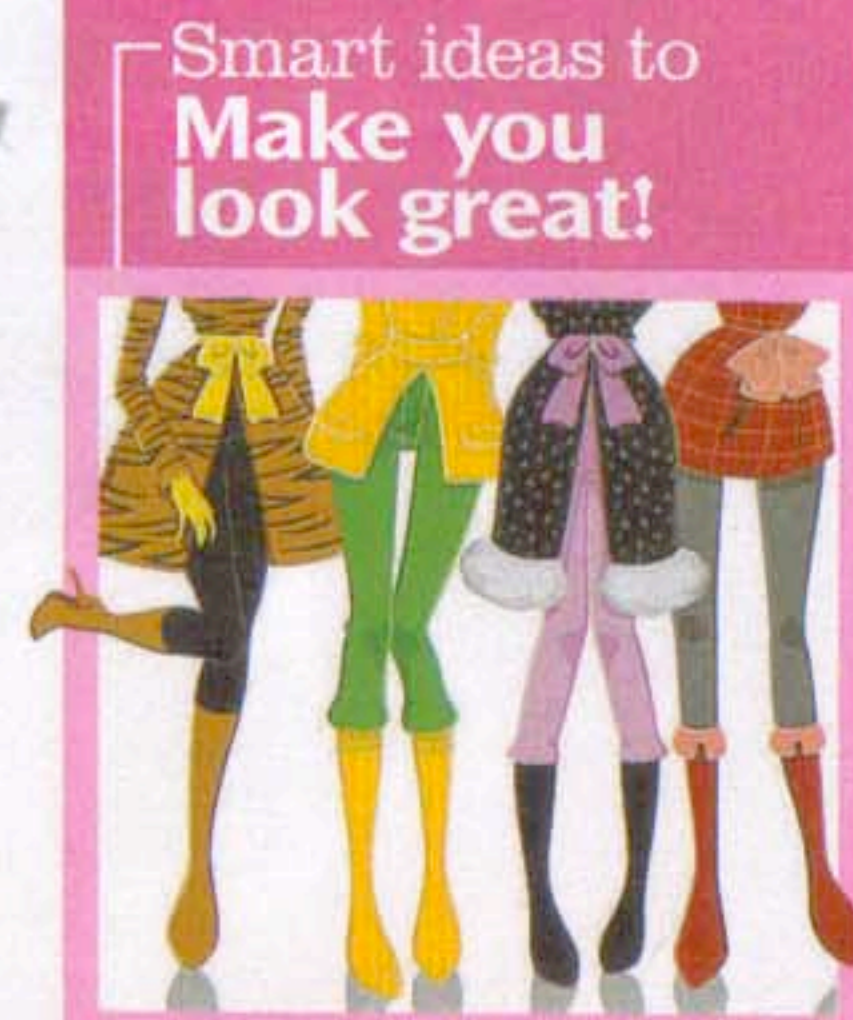


Fall trend:

1 Try the latest legging trend!
If you thought summer's denim leggings—or "jeggings"—were cute, keep an eye out for fall's new military-style ones. In colors like army green, khaki and dark gray, they have more seaming and details than regular leggings but feel just as comfy under tunics or long sweaters.

2 Sidestep itchy toes!
Spending all day in tights and boots can cause irritation between cramped toes. Prevent itchiness with a thin layer of a silky "blister block" stick applied between toes in the morning.
