



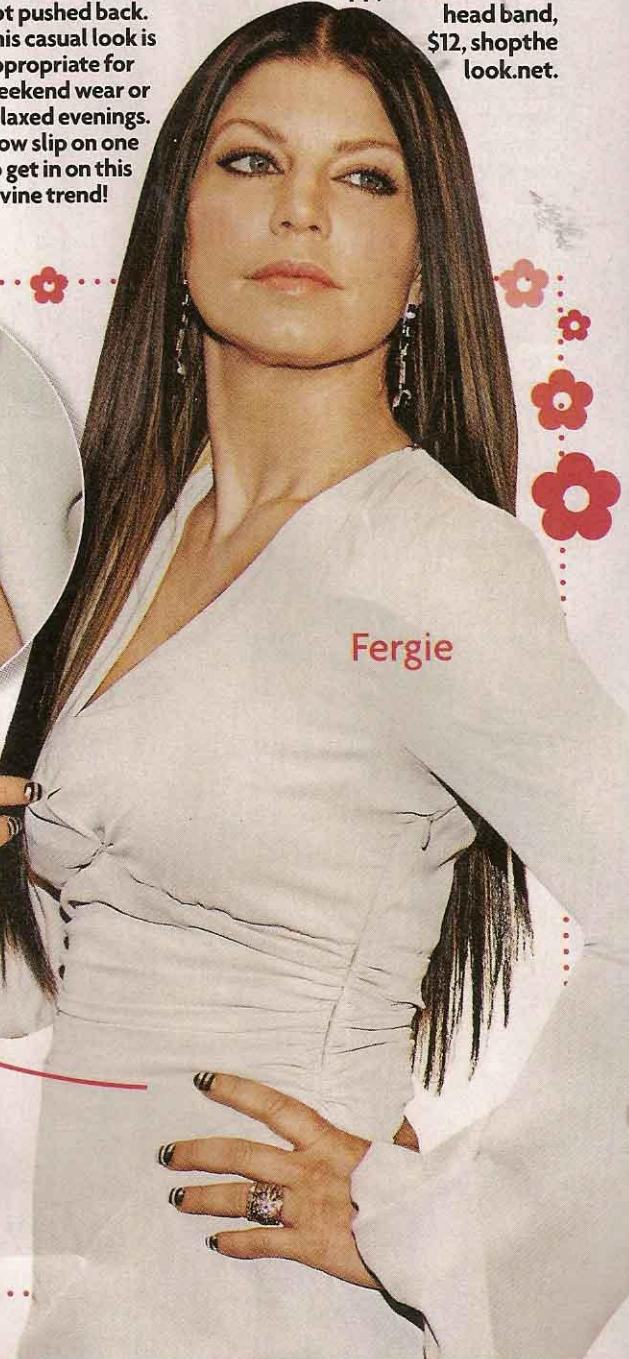

## 5. Nail Art

**D**ESIGNS on nails are back! So hit the salon or try it at home with these tips from famed celeb nail guru Jin Soon Choi: Polish nails as usual, but be sure the polish color you choose as the canvas for your art is light — in Fergie’s case, it’s silver. Why? Light polish will not show over dark. Then, if you have a steady hand, use a fine paintbrush to draw designs with a dark polish (e.g., diagonal lines). Novice? Try new nail art pens — they’re like markers and are supereasy to use. Alternatively, apply decal stickers over thoroughly dry polish. To finish and seal in your designs, coat with clear polish.
