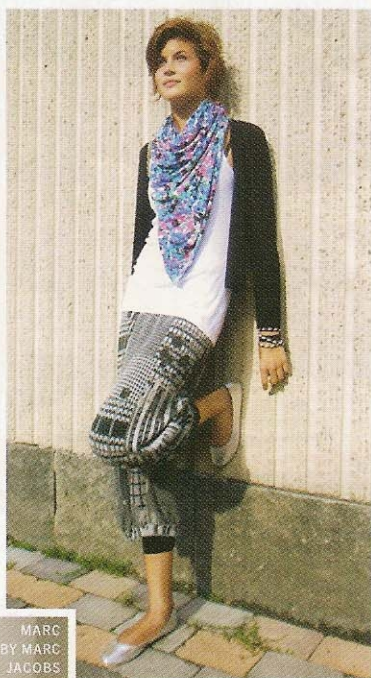
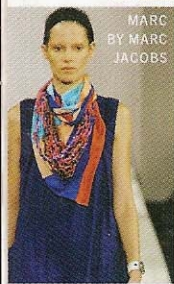


# lucky how-to
